AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE STORAGE OF PERSONALTY

The Town Board of the Town of Medary, La Crosse County, Wisconsin, acting under the powers of a village, does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Nuisance. Storage of old, unused, stripped, junked, unlicensed, and/or other automobiles not in condition for normal use or in good and safe operating condition, and/or of any other vehicles, machinery, implements, and/or equipment and personal property of any kind which is no longer usable for the purpose for which is manufactured, which hereinafter are collectively described as "said personalty", for a period of thirty days or more (except in licensed junk yards) is hereby declared to be a nuisance and dangerous to the public safety.

Section 2. Abatement by Owner. The owner, owners, tenants, lessees, and/or occupants of any lot within the Town upon which such storage is made, and also the owner, owners, and/or lessees of said personalty involved in such storage (all of whom will hereinafter be referred to collectively as owners). Shall jointly and severally abate said buildings authorized to be used for such storage purposes, or otherwise to remove it to a location without the corporate limits of the Town and it shall be unlawful if said owners allow said nuisance to exist or fail to abate said nuisance.

<u>Section 3.</u> <u>Penalty.</u> Any person violating any of the provisions thereof shall upon conviction be fined not less than \$70.00 nor more than \$400.00 for each offense, and in default of payment of said fine shall be imprisoned in the county jail for a period not exceeding 30 days. Each day that junk shall be stored contrary to the provisions hereof shall constitute a separate and distinct offense.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force upon its passage and publication.
