REGULATING THE USE OF DEVICES TO FRIGHTEN BIRDS AND ANIMALS AND PROVIDING PENALTIES AND THESE REGULATIONS ARE DECLARED TO BE IN THE INTEREST OF PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY, WELFARE, AND CONVENIENCE.

The Town Board of the Town of Medary, La Crosse County, Wisconsin, acting under the powers of a Village Board, do ordain as follows:

<u>Section 1.</u> No person shall use a device to frighten birds or animals by means of repeated sounds between the hours of sunset and sunrise.

<u>Section 2. Penalties.</u> Any person violating any provision of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, forfeit not less than Twenty- five Dollars (\$25.00) nor more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) and the costs of prosecution, and, in case of default of payment of such forfeiture or costs, shall be imprisoned in the County Jail until payment of such forfeiture and the costs of prosecution, but not Exceeding thirty (30) days, for each violation. Each day of violation shall constitute a separate offense.

<u>Section 3.</u> Effective <u>Date</u>. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
