Tom Brown then mentioned that having the sign out where it is helps make it so people can see what's coming from both directions.

Tom Brown mentioned that another tire was left on the side of the road.

Salt/sand has to be back by March 28, 2016.

Seidel received a phone call from a gentleman that lives on Vista Ct who has driveway pavers, and says the road is full of sand. He was hoping the brooming and sweeping would be more timely, but, as a note, it can never be more timely because we never know when the snow is going to end.

Someone called Town Hall about the dip on Smith Valley right after the bridge, but it is due to frost and will be better in a couple weeks.

Citizen Concerns

Duane Deml asked how the town pays for major road repair. We get so much money from the state and then we budget the rest. If the extent of road work is too large, we would borrow from the general fund.

Duane Deml wondered about the possibility of putting in a nice walking/biking path along Smith Valley Rd. Is it possible to get state funds for this?
